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You will need consent from research participants for the inclusion of their personal data in your thesis, to ensure compliance with data protection legislation and also to address any concerns about the publication of sensitive or confidential information. For particularly sensitive material, you may wish to seek consent for publication in an appendix to which access is restricted. Sample wording explaining about online deposit is available on the CUREC website ([www.admin.ox.ac.uk/curec](http://www.admin.ox.ac.uk/curec)) to include in participant information.
