Jesus College is delighted to offer Associate Membership to all students on the Oxford Diploma in Global Business course at Saïd Business School.

Jesus College was founded in 1571 By Elizabeth I. With Sir Nigel Shadbolt as its Principal, the College comprises some 66 Fellows (including one in Management), 20 lecturers, 200 graduates (including those undertaking the MBA, EMBA, and DPhil in Management), 350 undergraduates, and 90 support staff.

Jesus College has a strong commitment to promoting and enabling education, learning, scholarship and research at the highest levels amongst its students and academic staff, whilst preserving an informal and friendly atmosphere.

The College is located on an attractive historic site in the centre of Oxford, a short walk from Saïd Business School and with excellent access to the Bodleian Library and other university libraries.

Social events

- Students will be invited to all social and academic events held by the college MCR (the Middle Common Room), during their Diploma.
- Jesus College will host a welcome drinks reception and a guided tour of the College during the first module in February.
- Students will be invited to a number of College events throughout the year. Events will include the London Drinks, and future events with a business theme.

Dining

- There are two sittings for dinner in Jesus College each evening, except on Saturdays: 5.45pm - 6.30pm (informal), and 7.15pm - 9.30pm (formal, three courses). The group can always book in advance, via the Development Office, for the informal sitting. If students would like a formal dinner, they should book this in advance, for the Tuesday night of their module. Please note that formal dinner bookings are subject to availability.
- Diploma students will receive a 35% discount on all College dining. The cost is £15 per head for informal hall, and £30 per head for formal hall.
- Students may also book for lunches, at a cost of £12 per person. Cafeteria lunch service operates Monday-Friday 12.15pm - 1.30pm, and Saturday and Sunday 12.15pm - 1pm

Accommodation

- The college regrets that it is not able to offer all Diploma students accommodation during their time in Oxford. The College has just enough rooms for all of its current first year Undergraduates, and as the February, June and October modules fall within term-time, there are few spare rooms available. Jesus College is happy to provide information on alternative accommodation options in the city.
- All students can, however, book rooms in advance for the April module as that falls outside of term-time, subject to availability.
- Rooms cost is £52.50 per night, a discount of 43%, and can be booked via the Jesus College webpage <http://www.jesus.ox.ac.uk/visitors/accommodation>, and discount codes can be obtained by emailing events@jesus.ox.ac.uk. (The rates quoted are for single rooms)

Please note that the College is not a hotel, and is only able to offer guests the basic student service.

Access to College

- Students have access to the MCR – the Middle Common Room – during their Diploma, with tea and coffee-making facilities and a television.
- Jesus College regrets that it cannot offer study space in the College library to SBS students.

Associate Membership of Jesus College after graduation

Following the completion of the course, all Associate Members would become Associate Alumni of Jesus College.

Social events

- Associate Alumni will be invited to a programme of events in Oxford, London and internationally, throughout the year.
- Jesus College will host a reunion dinner for the Diploma students every five years.

Dining

- The alumni from the Diploma are able to book dinner for themselves and a guest in the Hall on any Sunday night during term-time. They have the option of attending the Evensong in the Chapel followed by a three course meal at a cost of £30. This should be booked via the Development Office events email.

Accommodation

- Rooms can be booked by alumni via the events email for £65 per night, a discount of 30%. (The rates quoted are for single rooms)

Access to College

- Alumni from the Diploma will be invited to College events throughout the year, in London and Oxford. They will also be informed about any international events the College is hosting in their home cities.

Connecting

- Alumni will be able to join the College's Facebook, Twitter and LinkedIn groups, all of whom have more than 1,000 contacts.
- The Development Office will be happy to put students in touch with other Jesus College alumni in their home country or city, subject to permission, and help them to facilitate local alumni groups for socialising or professional networking.
- Associate Alumni will receive the following publications to keep up to date with College news: The bi-annual newsletter; the bi-monthly e-bulletin, and the annual Record.
